Student Exchange Scholarship 2009

PURPOSE

The Student Exchange Scholarship fund was established to offer financial assistance to students who wish to participate in a student exchange program with one of Norfolk's recognized Sister Cities.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to receive an award the student must be recommended by the chair of the destination city. Committee chairs shall demonstrate their endorsement of the candidate by signing the scholarship application in the designated area.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Requirements from each applicant should include the following:

1. Completed application with appropriate signatures.
2. Letter of recommendation from a current/former teacher, pastor, or employer noting the applicant's personal achievements, including but not limited to honors, work experiences, community service, and extracurricular activities.

Incomplete applications will not be considered. Applications should be submitted to: Scholarship Committee, Norfolk Sister City Association, Inc., P.O. Box 3074, Norfolk, VA 23514

SELECTION

A selection committee consisting of NSCA members will choose the recipients of the scholarship award. The committee may, at its option, elect to interview finalists. The decision of the committee shall be final.

DEADLINE

The Scholarship Committee chair should receive all application materials by **April 30, 2009**. Late applications will not be considered.

THE AWARD

The scholarship award sum may vary from year to year and applicant to applicant. The sum of the awards shall depend on the success of the Association's fund raising efforts for this purpose. Recipients will be notified in May 2009.
